- The editorial board has the right to make the proper modifications wherever necessary.
- Drafts are not to be returned whether published or not.
- The researcher should pay (50000) ID as review fees (\$50 for research papers from outside Iraq, transferred via Western Union), as well as a publication fee (75000) ID (or \$75 for the research papers from outside Iraq), when the research is accepted for publication.
- The researcher should submit an e-copy as well as four printed copies of the research paper and three printed copies for papers in Arabic and English.

- The paper should include an abstract in Arabic concerning papers written in English, or in English regarding ones written in Arabic.
